This project takes place on portions of the Hills Bay shoreline.
 - 5.C. **Richard Hazlegrove, VMRC #22-2296, Map 25 (A) 138, 146 Elsie Lane** – Request to install approximately 16’ of riprap revetment, rework approximately 215’ of existing riprap revetment. This project takes place on portions of the East River shoreline.
 - 5.D. **2645 East River Road LLC, VMRC #22-2373, Map 25 (A) 9, 2645 East River Road** – Request to install a 12’x70 concrete boat ramp. This project takes place on portions of the East River shoreline.
 - 5.E. **Miles Clarkson, VMRC #22-2524, Map 34 (A) 126, 617 Quail Road** – Request to install approximately 75’ of riprap revetment and 45’ sill with appropriate backfill and plantings. This project takes place on portions of the East River shoreline.
 - 5.F. **Thomas Chupp, VMRC #22-2574, Map 10G (A) 6, 6995 Buckley Hall Road**– Request to install approximately 605’ of riprap revetment against an existing bulkhead that is failing. This project takes place on portions of the Queens Creek shoreline.
